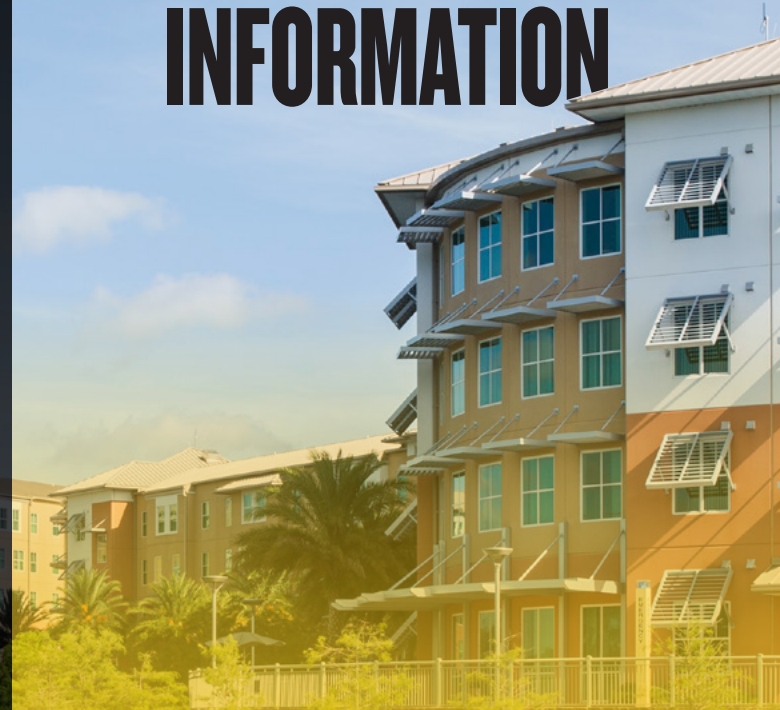

# RESIDENTIAL PARKING LOCATIONS

**Monday through Friday**

**7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.**

Campus residents must park in their designated R, KP, or RL permit location. Parking in green D permit spaces, or any space other than the locations designated for your specific housing community, will subject you to a parking citation.

After 5:30 p.m., you may park in any green D, blue C or red B space with your orange or purple campus resident permit.

## NEED TO RUN AN ERRAND?

There are designated pickup and drop-off spots located around the residential areas. These spots have a 20-minute time limit, so please remember to move your vehicle to your designated parking area in time to avoid parking citations.



## NOSE-IN PARKING

All vehicles on campus must park nose-in and plate-out. No back-in or pull-through parking is allowed.

## GET YOUR VIRTUAL PERMIT

Campus residents must purchase a virtual permit for their vehicle. To get your virtual permit, register your vehicle and pay online at [parking.ucf.edu](https://parking.ucf.edu). Your license plate is your permit.

Please note campus residents can only purchase a residential permit for their designated on-campus community.
